AAPS/EUFEPS GLOBAL BIOEQUIVALENCE HARMONIZATION INITIATIVE (GBHI): 4TH INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP

For several years now, the European Federation for Pharmaceutical Sciences (EUFEPS), with its Network on Bioavailability and Biopharmaceutics (BABP) in the lead, has worked toward harmonizing the requirements for bioequivalence assessment. This goal was encouraged from the beginning by the European Medicines Agency (EMA) as well as the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA). To support the intended process of global harmonization scientifically, a series of international conferences was started by EUFEPS in collaboration with AAPS. The first one was held in 2015 in Amsterdam/The Netherlands, followed by a second one in 2016 in Rockville/USA, and a third one in 2018 again in Amsterdam.

All conferences were characterized by open discussions and constructive exchange between regulatory scientists, academia and industry. Thus, these contributed significantly to the debate on a worldwide harmonization of bioequivalence requirements. Also regulators and speakers from other countries/regions, e.g. Canada, Chile, China, India, Japan, Jordan, Mexico, and Brazil, attended and contributed to the discussions. Such global participation has formed an ideal platform for scientists from the pharmaceutical industry and academia to exchange their experience and views with regulators. Scientific consensus achieved at the end of processes such as these should constitute the most appropriate basis for harmonization.
