- A full-day Masterclass on 25 November 2025 focusing on the responsible use of artificial intelligence (AI) in clinical pharmacy research.

- Sixteen workshops over three days, oral and poster research presentations, and meetings of Special Interest Groups.
- Coverage of emerging topics such as the integration of digital health technologies, AI-enabled medication adherence solutions, and simulation-based education and training.
- A dedicated “Steve Hudson Lecture” (during lunch), sponsored sessions, and networking opportunities for participants across Europe and beyond.

As the global healthcare community continues to confront workforce shortages and structural challenges, the symposium underscores the importance of interprofessional collaboration — a strategy endorsed by the World Health Organization (WHO) to strengthen health-care delivery. Through collaboration across disciplines and leveraging innovations such as AI and simulation, clinical pharmacists and other health professionals can more effectively contribute to patient-centred care.

UMF “Carol Davila” Announces the 13th Edition of Its Annual Congress 23-25 October 2025, Palatul Parlamentului, Bucharest, Romania

The University of Medicine and Pharmacy “Carol Davila” (UMFCD) will hold the 13th edition of its Annual Congress from 23 to 25 October 2025 at the Palace of the Parliament in Bucharest. The event is expected to gather more than 6,000 participants, making it the largest academic medical meeting in Romania.

The 2025 programme spans five lecture halls and two arenas, featuring plenary sessions, parallel symposiums, oral and poster presentations, and an expanded agenda in dental medicine.

The opening ceremony will include a commemorative film dedicated to Daniel Danielopolu and a classical music recital.

This year’s congress will also confer the title of *Doctor Honoris Causa* on two distinguished international scholars: Roxana Stegăroiu (Japan) and Konstantinos Sapalidis (Greece). The event is accredited for continuing education: 18 CME credits for physicians, 24 for dentists, and 32 for pharmacists.
